

PASTORAL MESSAGE

I Make All Things New!

Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, I make all things new." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful." And He said to me, "It[c] is done! I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts. He who overcomes [d]shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son. (Rev. 21:5-7)

Beloved Brothers and Sisters of Annunciation:

September 1 marks the beginning of the new Church Year, and we are invited (expected) by our Lord to continue to cultivate our relationship with Him and with those around us, the household of faith. Our renewal and growth derive solely from the One who is the "fountain of life," the Alpha and the Omega. Referring to the Orthodox Study Bible (Old & New Testament edition, available in our bookstore), there are 1749 pages, comprising the most amazing love letter the world has known from God to His people. On page 5, "God said, let Us make man in our image, according to Our likeness." (Genesis 1:26), and then some 1740 pages later, He closes with the promise that we will be his sons and daughters. And He said to me, "It is done!" What is done? If it's done, what is there left for us to do? Why not just "let God, let go?" The answer to this rhetorical question is found on pages 5 to 1749 in the Bible. The Scriptures are an open portal to viewing salvation history, but this view is fully experienced liturgically, most importantly by immersing ourselves in the Divine Liturgy. The 3rd c. Church Father St. Cyprian wrote, "You cannot have God as your Father without the Church as your Mother." A corollary here is, you cannot receive or understand God's love letter (the Bible) without the mind of the Church, and the only way to appropriate this mind is to be fully present. In other words, there's no substitute for experience-come to Church! My beloved brothers and sisters, there is no such thing as a solitary Christian. We are saved together as the Body of Christ. We need each other to "be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height-to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God (Ephesians 3:18-19).

As we strive together in the New Year to know the love of Christ, I ask for your prayers in your private devotions, but more importantly to join our beloved Annunciation Church family each and every Lord's day for the Eucharistic celebration, the full expression of God's love for us, where indeed, He makes all things new.

Dear Parishioners of Annunciation,

As many of you may know, this community came together recently to honor the passing of my brother, George Michael Dariotis. After many years of being bolstered by the prayers and support of our church as he fought cancer for more than a decade, George passed peacefully on July 12, 2023. It was all exactly as George would have wanted it to be. And I think he particularly would have enjoyed his fellow Parish Council Member, Demitri Romas, poignant and funny remarks, as well as the wonderful performances by my nieces Alianna and Georgia, at the end.

There are so many people who worked so hard, so quickly, and so graciously to make this a fitting tribute to George. Thank you to Father James and Father Tim for all their daily visits during George's last week. Thank you to Father Dino for coming to both services, and thank you to Father Jon Magoulias and to His Eminence for coming to the Trisagion. Thank you to Rula Manikas for coordinating the reception after the Trisagion and the Makeria. We were blessed to have such wonderful caterers Jim and Faye Vallas, Voula Cazanis and Vasili Tsigaris, and to eat their delicious meal together. And I could not have imagined getting through this time without my fellow Parish Council members and their outpouring of love and support.

When you lose two siblings so close together you become humbled. I am committed more than ever to serve this community that has given me and my family so much, and to work even harder for others in their honor. I will continue to do my best as President of the Parish Council to honor George's legacy. I am forever grateful to George and to all of you.





Dear Greek School families and supporters,

After ten years of serving the mission of Annunciation Greek School, I am stepping down as an instructor and academic director. This is a very difficult decision that I had to make in order to pursue a unique professional opportunity presented to me at UC Davis—one that conflicts with the time investment that my involvement in Greek School requires.

Annunciation Greek School has been a big and important part of my life for the past ten years. I was blessed to work alongside a team of gifted and devoted colleagues as well as an extremely supportive board. During my tenure, Annunciation Greek School has maintained a strong student body—even during the pandemic— and consistently offered a wide range of classes—from pre-K, to exam certification, to advanced adult classes—and, in 2018, became a certified Ellinomatheia exam center. There have been many moments that stand out in this journey: the 10 awards (in the categories of creative writing, singing, photography, arts and crafts, and drama) that our students received in the Greek Letters contests organized by the Metropolis of San Francisco and Annunciation Greek School's success rates at the Ellinomatheia exams ranging from 87.5% to 100% in the past 5 years. Last but not least, 6 of our former students have received the State Seal of Biliteracy upon their High School graduation for having succeeded in the B1 Ellinomatheia Exams.

I will always be grateful to my amazing students and their families, as well as to the devoted colleagues and board members with whom I was fortunate to work. Contributing to the mission of this important ministry in our community has been a rare privilege and a true honor for me!

I want to thank you all for your faith in me and your support of the Greek School program all these years.
